

John Poynton's UKIP Policy Discussion Paper No.7

Environmental protection.

Herewith a simple list of policies for protecting the environment:

1. An immigration policy aimed at **NET VOLUNTARY EMIGRATION** of at least 50,000 a year,
2. Build overflow containment tanks at all **SEWAGE WORKS** to prevent storm overflow into our rivers and the sea,
3. Take back control of our waters and allocate 25% to **NO FISHING ZONES**,
4. Reward identification of **PLASTICS** and other contaminants such as fishing nets in our waters so specialist teams can remove them,
5. Reverse the charges at our tips, so people are rewarded rather than penalised for taking stuff to them to end **FLY-TIPPING**,
6. Dredge our rivers to minimise **FLOODING**, and where towns are particularly at risk build by-pass sewers and other defences as appropriate,
7. Ensure our **COASTAL DEFENCES** are adequate to prevent erosion and flooding,
8. Preserve our **GREEN BELTS**. They are there for a reason,
9. Insert maximum **POPULATION DENSITY** rules into our planning laws and build new **PARKS** and plant **TREES** in our towns and cities,
10. Use long thin Scottish sea lochs for **TIDAL** electricity generation.
